Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a citizen or resident of Lebanon or a holder of the Special Travel Document for Palestinian Refugees.
- Must reside in Lebanon throughout the selection process.
- Must hold a U.S.-equivalent bachelor's degree by the program start date.
- Must have a strong academic background.
- Must be proficient in English or able to attend a Long-Term English program in the United States prior to the start of the academic program.
- Must have 2 years of professional work experience if applying to MBA programs.







Fulbright Long Term English Program

- Improve your English
 Language skills.
- Live and study on a U.S. university campus.
- Receive full tuition and a monthly living allowance for the LTE program .
- Improve your English proficiency score and increase your chances of receiving admission at a U.S. university.

Qualified Fulbright nominees who need to enhance their English language skills may be nominated to participate in a Long-Term English (LTE) program before the start of their academic program in the United States.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- You must first apply to and be nominated for the Fulbright Foreign Student Program to be considered for the LTE program.
- The Fulbright Program will inform eligible candidates if they have been selected for an LTE program.
- LTE programs are 6-8 months in duration and begin in January and March.
- Dependents cannot accompany LTE participants.
